Board's Welcome & Business

- Outdoor classroom plans update the PTO has the plans which were passed around during the meeting. Teachers and students had input. PTO met with the architect, Facilities, Dr. Jocelyn, and Ms. Costa. Will include bench seating inside that's enclosed. Will also include wheelchair seating. Seating design can be easily fixed if there is graffiti. May be able to have South Shore Vo-Tech build it, however they can't build it until the Fall. It will be the most cost effective. Asking Cape Cod Lumber if their engineers can develop a supply list. Cape Code Lumber is also asking if other products can be donated. South Shore Vo-Tech and Cape Code Lumber will provide cost estimate. South Shore Vo-Tech cannot make a profit. Also discussed how in the future we will need to pay for landscaping. Facilities will level out the land.
