4 Board's Welcome & Business

- The meeting was conducted virtually over Zoom because a lot of parents were home with sick kids, and some of the PTO Board was home sick.
- Outdoor classroom plans update the fencing has been dropped off. The next step is excavation but the ground has been too frozen. It has taken a while as well to get permits. Once excavation happens the temporary fence will be put up. The plan is for the build to happen in the summer and fall but that could get moved up. The fence will remain up until South Shore Vo Tech can come back.
- Gift of Scholastic Dollars to Indian Head teachers. All teachers, paras, and specialists have been allotted up to \$100 to use on the Scholastic catalog to purchase resources for their classrooms, as a gift from the PTO. Staff have through 2/28 to create their wish lists and the PTO will place and deliver the orders.

Principals' Update

- Alison noted that she has the check for the Cricut bundle and will bring it in tomorrow.
- Ms. Costa noted over 100 kids are absent each day due to illnesses. Some teachers have postponed Valentine's day celebrations due to illnesses.
- Discussed the PTO Valentine's day dance. Ms. Costa wanted to bring to our attention that a lot of kids were running everywhere and parents were not watching them. Some kids went outside onto the blacktop. This could be a liability for the PTO and the school. Ms. Costa also made sure all classrooms were locked but when the cleaners came they unlocked some of them, not knowing they were already locked. Teachers reported that some of the things in their classroom were moved. Ms. Costa viewed the security videotape and observed that some students entered classrooms with their parents. Ms. Costa is not able to police all the classrooms. Discussed how areas need to be roped off and maybe manned by a volunteer. Contributing may have been the fact that the second DJ didn't show up, who would have provided entertainment in a second area. There were a couple collisions due to the kids

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running in the halls. The message is, parents need to stay with their kids. Ms. Costa also received some emails from parents that kids were out of control.
