Board's Welcome & Business

- Outdoor classroom plans update had a meeting with Steve who has offered to design the plans. The site will be near the current playground. The area will need to be leveled out. The structure will be a circular shape. He is doing the plans at zero cost and should be done with the plans soon. He is reaching out to his contractor contacts to see if they can donate labor.
- Update on Scholastic Dollars gift to teachers/paras/specialists of \$100 each to order items for their classrooms, as well as \$300 for Mrs. Travers for the library we have \$7,038 in Scholastic Dollars (after the order). We spent \$2,998 in wish list items for 33 teachers/paras/specialists. They were grateful. Also updated on book fair sales. We had \$9,968 in book sales, and earned \$5,184 in Scholastic Dollars. This exceeded the May sales of \$8,812. We have enough Scholastic Dollars for teacher requests and One School One Book.

Principals' Update

- o Dr. Jocelyn rode a bike inside the school as part of Fun Run incentives.
- o Did progress reports for WIN blocks. Some students will make up their test next week.
- There is no WIN on half days.
- o 92.5% of parents participated in parent/teacher conferences. He did not have the % of those virtual vs. in person.
- For intervention, there are 6-8 kids per group and it is skill based. Dr. Jocelyn presented data to the Superintendent on improvements and was able to get funding. The intervention groups come in at 8am.
- The school also started a mentoring program. All adults are involved and they have a meeting with their mentee for about 15 minutes a couple times a week. Sometimes they have lunch together. There are also student helpers. It helps the students connect to an adult for support who is not their teacher. 50 adults participate. That is going to start the first week of December.

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- The dates for the winter and spring concerts are being compiled.
- There will be a fire safety day 11/15 and will have presentations by grade.
- o In December, Officer Harrington will do a stranger danger and social media presentation.
